### Open Classes

The goat classes are to be held under the Rules, Regulations and Recognition of the British Goat Society. All exhibits must be registered with the BGS as in the ownership and in the name of the exhibitor, the registered name, number and earmark being quoted on the entry form (also the kidding date for goats in milk). All goats in milk must have been kidded or aborted a minimum of 30 days previous to the date of show.

No pregnant goats may be admitted to the show ground. In the event of an unforeseen kidding or abortion, the goat must be immediately isolated from other goats. Full details of the goat, exhibitor and any action taken must be reported in writing to the Chief Steward and the BGS Secretary immediately after the show. **The registered number of any goat, initially entered as RAF, must be submitted to the Chief Steward before the goat competes.**

Entries will be accepted from whole negative CAE tested herds and monitored herds, both must be submitted on BGS or Health Scheme Forms. Exhibitors are requested NOT to bring to the showground ANY goat that has previously had a positive reaction to the CAE test; it is advised that any milk produced at the show should not be fed to the goats of any age.

All goats must conform to the current regulations regarding identification, all earmarks and tags must be readable.

Goats in milk should arrive on the Friday evening prior to the show by 6.00pm for stripping out by an official steward at 6.30pm.

Young stock must be penned by 9am on the day of the show.

First inspection will take place at 6.30am on the Saturday morning (subject to the judge's approval).

No goats should be removed from the show ground until 5pm on the Saturday, with approval from the Chief Steward.

##### Goats in Milk, (double pen)

Entered in both milking & inspection £3.50

Entered in milking or inspection only £2.25

**Goatlings** (single pen each) £2.25

**Kids** (single pen per two kids) £2.25

#### Prize Money:

**Goats in Milk** (inspection & milking comp) 1<sup>st</sup> - £10, 2<sup>nd</sup> - £8, 3<sup>rd</sup> - £6, 4<sup>th</sup> - £2

**Goatlings & Kids** 1<sup>st</sup> - £5, 2<sup>nd</sup> - £4, 3<sup>rd</sup> - £3, 4<sup>th</sup> - £2

(Please note Third and Fourth prize money will only be paid where there are four or six entries respectively.)

16. **Female Kids** over 2 months, but not exceeding one year, entered in the **Saanen** or **British Saanen** section of the Herd Book.
17. **Female Kids** over 2 months, but not exceeding one year, entered in the **Anglo Nubian** section of the Herd Book.
18. **Female Kids** over 2 months, but not exceeding one year, entered in the **British Alpine** section of the Herd Book.
19. **Female Kids** over 2 months, but not exceeding one year, entered in the **Golden Guernsey** section of the Herd Book.
20. **Female Kids** over 2 months, but not exceeding one year, **Any Other Variety**.
  
21. **Milking Competition**, for goats of any age, to have kidded once only.
22. **Milking Competition**, for goats of any age, to have kidded twice or more.
