Qualifies for: KBIS Insurance British Novice Championship - Second Round. Qualifying period yearly 1st May - 30th April inclusive. Numbers to qualify: Those horses which jump a clear round in the first round, followed by a clear round in the jump off, in at least four KBIS Insurance British Novice First Round competitions held in any qualifying period will qualify to compete in and attend four KBIS Insurance British Novice Second Rounds, irrespective of their placings for prize money in those competitions, which will be determined by the normal Table A rules (Rule 191). Horses in the class must go in to the jump-off and go clear to gain a double clear round qualification. Horses will only be eligible for double clear qualification to Second Rounds if they reach the age of five years or under in the same calendar year as the Discovery Final - in accordance with Rule 314.6 Qualifies for: Nupafeed Supplements Discovery Championship Second Round. Qualifying period: 1st May-30th April inclusive. Numbers to qualify: Those horses that jump a clear round in the first round, followed by a clear round in the jump off, in at least four First Round competitions held in any qualifying period, will qualify to compete in and attend four Second Rounds, irrespective of their placings for prize money in those competitions, which will be determined by the normal Table A Rules (Rule 191). Horses in the class must go in to the jump-off and go clear to gain a double clear round qualification. Eligibility – For any horse/rider, pony/rider combination without a registered result in National Amateur 90 cm, British Novice, Pony British Novice, Stepping Stones above in the last 3 years. Unaffiliated competitors can compete without being a Club Member.

Competitor can register as Club Members for 7 days after the competition regain Point Won.

Any age rider on ponies (adult eligible to ride ponies).

Children can ride horses from the beginning of the calendar year in which the age of 12 is reached (FEI Rules).

## **Faults:**

Knock down – 4 faults

1<sup>st</sup> refusal – 4 faults

2<sup>nd</sup> refusal (anywhere on the course) – Elimination

Fall (anywhere on the course) – Elimination All other faults as per British Showjumping rule book.
